4	Remittent fever		Cycles frequently between periods of normal or subnormal temperatures

1	Out patient		Unplanned, emergency department bypassed
2	Emergency admission		Length of stay generally more than 24 hours
3	Direct admission		Unplanned, stabilized in emergency department and transferred to nursing care unit
4	In patient		length of stay less than 24 hours
